



TABA LASCADA COMMUNITY

Roraima



To coexist with people from this village that live in such simplicity is a real trip to the past. Although wapixana of Tabá Lascada are considered "people with some local culture", they still keep their language and traditions, passing their customs from father to son. The wapixana lives according to his historical records, at least 03 centuries in Serra da Lua's area. More ancient families from this place consist of Macuxi women married with Wapixana men; the majority comes from Serra da Lua.

Location: North of Boa Vista, Roraima's state capital.

Program: 04 days and 03 nights living together with the aborigines of the region, including dances, fishing, food and drink with the people of the community.



Day 1

Transfer Boa Vista Airport / Hotel

Day 2

06.30 – Departure from hotel with destination to the community (aprox. 1:30 hs trip)

08:00 – Community Typical breakfast / Getting to know the community: New and old houses; Handcraft factory observatory; Learn how to use some medicinal herbs / Lunch based on fish or meat / In the Afternoon Dance performance; Drink tasting with the community (caxiri, aluá, moco-ro-ro and others); Games. (pipe use, tribe paintings). Dinner based on fish or meat / At night integration with the group and presents exchange

Day 3

Community typical breakfast / Native fishing / Fauna and Flora Observation / Lunch based on fish or meat / In the afternoon Native games: Presentation of games with the participation of the visitor (Warrior fight, timber race, sack race and others) (Baskets, arch and arrow, zarabatana, necklaces and garments) / Dinner based on fish or meat. In the Evening, native legends and stories. (Told by the elders in the native language with translator).

Day 4

Community typical breakfast / Native fishing: Getting to know and learning how to use the fishing equipment; Using the equipment with the natives / Lunch based on fish or meat / Native Activities: Getting to know and learning how to use the hunting equipment. / Dinner based on fish or meat / Free evening for integration with the natives.



Day 5

Typical breakfast of the Community. Dance Performance (farewell). Exhibition of workmanship. (baskets, bow and arrow, zarabatana, necklaces and clothing). Lunch Regional Food. Afternoon Return to Boa Vista.

Day 6

Transfer Boa Vista Hotel / Airport
