



OVERFLY ON THE REGION OF GEOGLYPHS



A geoglyph is a drawing on the ground, or a large motif, (generally greater than 4 metres) or design produced on the ground, either by arranging clasts (stones, stone fragments, gravel or earth) to create a positive geoglyph (stone arrangement/alignment, petroform, earth mound) or by removing patinated clasts to expose unpatinated ground (negative geoglyph).

The forms measures have 113 to 200 meters in diameter and are between 30 centimeters to 4.5 meters in depth.

These forms were found in several different sites and their occurrence is restricted to Acre. The first discovery occurred in 1977 during the National Program of Archaeological Research in the Amazon Basin (Pro - Napaba).

All information available so far are not sufficient to determine the origin and function of geoglyphs.
