



Fernando de Noronha

A visit to Fernando de Noronha is guaranteed to be the trip of a lifetime. As well as its outstanding natural beauty and historical heritage, Noronha also offers numerous activities for tourists.

On the archipelago, there's the feeling that you're in one of the most unforgettable places in Brazil. 545 km off the coast of Pernambuco and 360 km from Rio Grande do Norte, Fernando de Noronha has a population of around 3 thousand that live on the main island, with an area of 17 square kilometres, around 20 smaller islands completing the paradisiacal scenery that covers a total of 26 km². Sustainably-run tourism enables a balanced co-existence between man and nature in one of the world's most important environmental sanctuaries.

A visit to Noronha requires a minimum of four days to enjoy the countless natural attractions and see some relics of our colonial history. There is a wide range of possible activities and excursions, catering for all tastes and providing the visitor the opportunity to appreciate the whole beauty of the islands.

In Fernando de Noronha, the average temperature is 28 °C on land and 26 °C at sea. There is a dry season (between September and March) and a rainy season (between April and August), when there are scattered showers interspersed with periods of intense sunshine.
