Day 1 - RIO DE JANEIRO

Assistance upon arrival and transfer to Hotel. Balance of the day. Overnight.

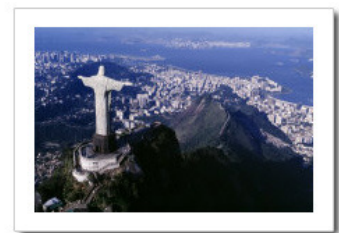
Day 2 - RIO DE JANEIRO

Breakfast. Today you will have a great opportunity to explore more of Rio de Janeiro and its surroundings areas with a tour to Sugar Loaf Mountain, the guardian of Guanabara Bay. Here, a thrilling cable car ride will take you to the top of Sugar Loaf, at 395 meters above the city.

Day 3 - RIO DE JANEIRO

Breakfast. In the morning you will go to Christ the Redeemer statue in the mountain of Corcovado, located at 710 meters above the sea level and inaugurated in 1931. The tour begins in Cosme Velho's neighborhood from where the cog train starts a trip through the Tijuca Forest, the largest urban forest in the world, up to the statue. Once there, a panoramic and extraordinary view of Rio. Afternoon free. In the evening, "Rio by Night", with dinner in one of Rio's famous Churrascarias. After dinner, you will proceed to a Samba Show houses.



Day 4 - RIO DE JANEIRO / SALVADOR

After Breakfast, transfer to the airport for your short flight to Salvador da Bahia. Assistance upon arrival and transfer to hotel. Balance of the day at leisure. Overnight



Day 5 – SALVADOR

Breakfast. Today's city tour will take you to see the Upper and Lower cities and the colonial remnants of their cobblestone-paved streets and stucco

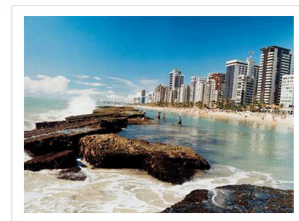
buildings, including the Sao Francisco Church, The Carmo Museum and Church, Mercado Modelo Market, and “ The largo do Pelourinho, where slaves were auctioned and punished during Colonial times. Balance of the day at leisure.

Day 6 - SALVADOR / RECIFE

After Breakfast, transfer to the airport for your short flight to Recife. Arrival and transfer to hotel.

Day 7 – RECIFE

Breakfast. Today’ s city tour will take you to see Recife colonial architecture and its historical downtown area, including the Brennand Ceramic Studios and The Casa da Cultura handicraft market. After Recife, you go to the colonial town of Olinda World heritage Monument, which boasts a wealth of Colonial architecture, notably the houses and churches of Alto da Sé, whilst its historical heritage keeps alive the story of Colonial Brazil. Overnight



Day 8 - RECIFE / MANAUS

After Breakfast, transfer to the airport for your short flight to Manaus. Assistance upon arrival and transfer to Ecopark Lodge. After Regional lunch, Visit to Monkey Jungle to observe the surrounding wildlife habitat. Return to lodge for dinner. After dinner, take a night excursion to go Alligator spotting by flashlight.



Day 9 - AMAZON ECOPARK LODGE

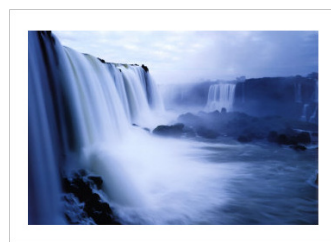

Dia 10 - AMAZON ECOPARK LODGE / FOZ DO IGUAÇU

After Breakfast, you will take a morning hike by its natural surroundings. Regional lunch followed by a visit to the home of local Amazonian residents (caboclos) with an opportunity for piranha fishing. Dinner

Dia 11 - FOZ DO IGUAÇU

Breakfast. Enjoy a tour to the Brazilian and Argentinean sides of the magnificent falls. View the Falls from the platform overlooking Devil’ s Throat; the main falls, from where the Iguassu River precipitates



Day 12 - IGUASSU FALLS / FINAL DESTINATION

After Breakfast, transfer to the airport for your flight to airport for your departure flight back home
